



### **Asthma Friendly School (AFS) Accreditation Process**

1. School contacts the Asthma Bundle Care team for Hampshire and the Isle of Wight or Dorset, depending on area.
2. School is sign posted to resources and self-assessment checklist on Healthier Together website
3. School uses self-assessment checklist to evaluate compliance against AFS criteria
4. Once school has met AFS criteria the school contact the Asthma Care Bundle team to conduct a review of practice against AFS criteria
5. If the school has met the criteria to become an AFS the Asthma Care Bundle team can complete the accreditation template, including (a) date of accreditation (b) date of review and (c) signature of Asthma Care Bundle team and school
6. The form will be sent to the Asthma Bundle of care team who will maintain records for review of AFS
7. The Asthma Bundle Care team will issue the school with a logo and certificate of accreditation
8. Asthma Bundle Care team will send reminder to schools every September reminding schools to check their practice against AFS criteria
9. Following a period of 3 years the Asthma Care Bundle team conducts a review of accredited Asthma Friendly Schools' practices against criteria to ensure that compliance remains
