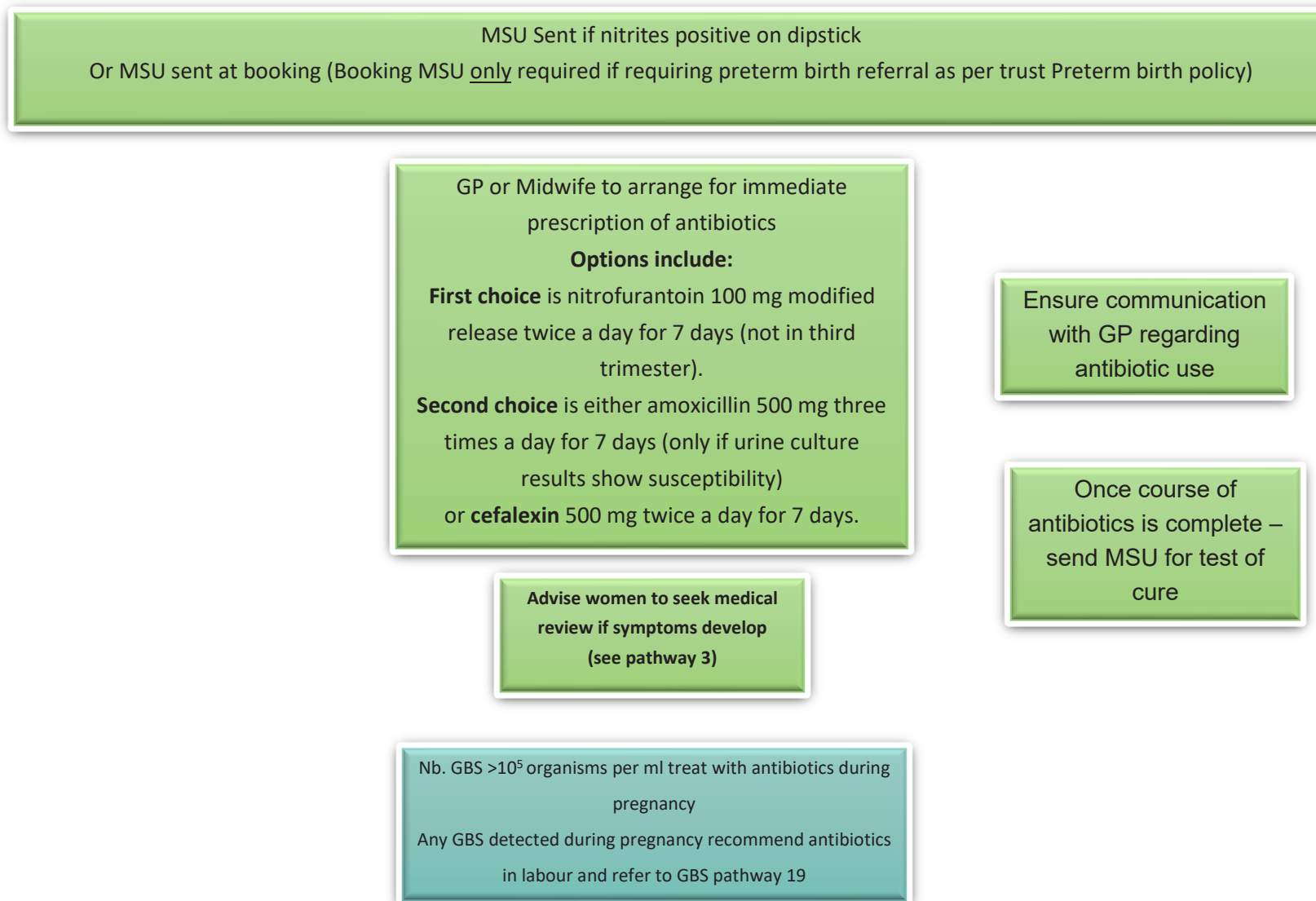

Scenario: Asymptomatic bacteriuria in pregnancy NICE CKS (2025) National Institute for Health and Care Excellence (NICE) guideline Urinary tract infections (lower): antimicrobial prescribing [NICE, 2022], the European Association of Urology (EAU) guideline Urological infections [EAU, 2023], and the Royal College of Obstetricians and Gynaecologists (RCOG) Green-top guideline Prevention of early-onset neonatal Group B streptococcal disease [RCOG, 2017] and the NHS England document Saving babies' lives: version 3 care bundle [NHS England, 2023].
